No Fiscal Impact

The amendment: 1) allows the candidate committee of a candidate for state senator or state representative to feature or refer to a statewide office candidate in any campaign communication, as long as such communication does not expressly promote the success of the statewide office candidate, and 2) exempts such communication from the definition of contribution as long as it does not promote the success of a statewide office candidate. No fiscal impact is anticipated to the State or municipalities as the amendment is making procedural changes to campaign finance statutes.
