Explanation

The amendment reduces the threshold of outstanding debt in the underlying bill, from \$10,000 to \$4,000, below which municipal water pollution control authorities (WCPAs) are prohibited from assigning or enforcing a lien on owner-occupied property.

The amendment reduces the revenue loss a municipal WCPA may incur as a result of the underlying bill. It does so by reducing the amount of debt to which the underlying bill's restrictions apply.
