OFA Fiscal Note

Cost

The amendment increases the fees paid to members of the State Board of Mediation and Arbitration (SBMA) for additional hearing days and executive panel sessions, which results in a General Fund cost to the Department of Labor (DOL) of \$32,325 annually. This is based on data from the DOL indicating that there were 53 additional hearing days and 37 executive panel sessions in FY 20, all of which involved three SBMA arbitrators.
