OFA Fiscal Note

Significant Cost

The amendment requires any municipality with a population of at least 60,000 to have an election monitor for the 2021 municipal election and the 2022 state election. The underlying bill set the population level at 140,000. The amendment will impact 13 cities. This will result in significant costs to the Secretary of the State estimated to be more than \$1 million.
