The amendment increases the penalty for a person over 23 years of age providing cannabis to a person under 21 years of age. This results in a potential marginal cost to the Department of Correction and the Judicial Department for increased prison and probation sentences and a potential revenue gain to the extent violations occur.

The amendment also makes various law enforcement policy changes resulting in no fiscal impact to the state.
