The meeting was called to order by Senator Maroney and recessed to go into caucus. The chairman then called the meeting back to order at 9:44 a.m.

Senator Witkos suggested that a consent calendar be started for the bills on the agenda. Senator Witkos then had Items number 1. SB 152 JF, 2. SB 267JF, 3. SB 268JF, and 4 SB 694 JFS (LCO 4345) put on the consent calendar.

Item number 5 SB 894 by Senator Witkos and seconded by Senator Kissel proposed the amendment that on line 46 the word may be changed to shall. The amendment passed and the bill was placed on the consent calendar.

Item 6 HB 5306 JFS (LCO 4215) motion may by Senator Witkos and seconded by Rep. D'Agostino that an amendment be made that the bill become effective immediately upon passage. Discussion followed if the executive order should be extended for 3 years so

that permittees will be able to sell alcohol off premise with food delivery or pick up. The clerk read the roll.

Senator Witkos proposed that items 7, HB 5308 JF, 8. HB 530 JF9, 9, HB 6217JF and 10, HB 6460 JFS (4046) be put on the consent calendar.

Item 11. HB 6459 the LCO number was corrected to 4483 with an amendment by Rep. Cheeseman seconded by Senator Witkos to amend the bill and have it effective immediately upon passage. The amendment passed on a voice vote and then placed on the consent calendar

Item 12, HB 5313 JFS (LCO 4527) was discussed. The clerk then called the roll.
