Representatives:

Representative D'Agostino called the meeting to order and asked for remarks. Senator Maroney thanked the staff especially Clerk Clark for the good job he has done.

Representative D'Agostino also thanked the clerk and Assistant Clerks Bonnie and Pam.

Representative asked if the bills on the agenda could be put on a consent calendar.

Senator Witkos suggested that we do them separately with a roll call.

A motion was made by Senator Witkos and seconded by Senator Maroney to JF to the floor SB 186. A discussion about the language and the age exclusion followed. The roll was called.

A motion was made by Senator Witkos and seconded by Representative Candelaria to JFS (LCO 5685) SB 693 to the floor. The roll was called.

A motion was made by Senator Witkos and seconded by Senator Maroney to JFS (LCO 5755) SB 893 to the floor. Senator Maroney explained that this bill was based on the Virginia Law and with the JFS language gives the Attorney General the ability to review. The roll was called.

A motion was made by Senator Witkos and seconded by Senator Maroney to JFS (LCO 5754 SB 895 to the floor. Senator Maroney and Representative discussed the changes to the pharmacy statues. The roll was called.

A motion was made by Senator Witkos and seconded by Senator Maroney to JF HB 5303 to the floor. The bill is being done as a study because of the overlap with federal laws. The roll was called.

Representative D'Agostino corrected the LCO number from (5865) to (5927).

Representative Candelaria made the motion and Senator Witkos seconded the motion. Representative D'Agostino explained that the change in LCO number came from the Attorney General because there is an ongoing law suit and because of that section 11 was removed. Representative Ackert expressed the lack of communications with the DCP with contractors. The roll was called.

A motion was made by Senator Witkos and seconded by Representative D'Agostino to JFS (LCO 5732) HB 6445 to the floor. This is the Governor's bill and there is ongoing discussion with the building trades and people coming into the state. The roll was called.

Representative D'Agostino stated that the votes and attendance will be kept open until the Senate goes into session or 11:00 a.m.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:00 a.m.
