Rep. Abercrombie made opening remarks.

Rep. Abercrombie asked for a motion to add item numbers 1-5 to the consent calendar: S.B. 763 An Act Requiring Drivers Of Paratransit Vehicles To Report Suspected Abuse, Neglect, Exploitation or Abandonment Of Elderly Persons, S.B. 765 An Act Concerning Eligibility For The Connecticut Home-Care Program For Persons With Disabilities, S.B. 853 An Act Concerning The State-Wide Health Information Exchange Board Of Directors, S.B. 854 An Act Concerning A List Of The 100 Most Delinquent Child Support

Obligors, and H.B. 6320 An Act Concerning The Autism Spectrum Disorder Advisory Council. The motion was made by Rep. Case and seconded by Rep. Wood.
