### **INTRODUCTION OF BILLS HOUSE AND SENATE BILLS**

#### **BANKING**

**H.B. No. 5610 (COMM) BANKING. 'AN ACT CONCERNING A STUDY BY THE CONNECTICUT HIGHER EDUCATION SUPPLEMENTAL LOAN AUTHORITY'**, to require the Connecticut Higher Education Supplemental Loan Authority to conduct a study.

**H.B. No. 6323 (COMM) BANKING. 'AN ACT REQUIRING THE BANKING COMMISSIONER TO UPDATE A REPORT ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A STATE-OWNED BANK'**, to require the Banking Commissioner to update a report on the establishment of a state-owned bank to address new developments concerning state-owned banks and bankers' banks.
