# INTRODUCTION OF BILLS HOUSE AND SENATE BILLS

'AN ACT AUTHORIZING BONDS OF THE STATE FOR A RESEARCH FACULTY RECRUITMENT AND HIRING PROGRAM BY THE UNIVERSITY OF CONNECTICUT TO ENCOURAGE THE CREATION OF NEW BUSINESS VENTURES', to provide funding for a research faculty recruitment and hiring program by The University of Connecticut, with the goal of encouraging and facilitating the creation of new business ventures.
- S.B. No. 1100 (RAISED) FINANCE, REVENUE AND BONDING. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE FAILURE TO FILE FOR CERTAIN GRAND LIST EXEMPTIONS', to allow certain persons to file for property tax exemptions, notwithstanding certain statutory deadlines.
- S.B. No. 1101 (RAISED) FINANCE, REVENUE AND BONDING. 'AN ACT ESTABLISHING CT RENAISSANCE AND CONCERNING INVESTMENTS IN RENAISSANCE ZONES', to require the establishment of the CT Renaissance to implement investments and project financing in eligible municipalities through designated renaissance zones, and to increase the funds for state investments in community banks and credit unions to promote community or economic development in such zones.

'AN ACT CONCERNING EMISSIONS AND DECIBEL LEVEL TESTING, THE TAXATION OF CERTAIN MOTORCYCLES AND PARTS AND THE PASSPORT TO THE PARKS FEE', to require emissions and decibel level testing for motor vehicles and motorcycles, establish a higher rate of sales and use taxes for motorcycles and aftermarket motorcycle mufflers that exceed the maximum allowable decibel level and limit the Passport to the Parks fee to one vehicle per owner.
