

JOURNAL OF THE HOUSE

Monday, May 10, 2021

The House of Representatives was called to order at 10:55 o'clock p.m., in accordance with the provisions of House Rule 50, and under the authority of the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the House Minority Leader.
