INTRODUCTION OF BILLS SENATE AND HOUSE BILLS AND RESOLUTIONS

In accordance with the provisions of Senate Rule 9(A), the first reading of the following bills and resolutions was waived, the list of bills and resolutions as prepared by the Clerks was accepted, and the bills and resolutions referred to the Committees as indicated thereon in concurrence:

BANKING

S.B. No. **848** (RAISED) BANKING. 'AN ACT IMPLEMENTING THE DEPARTMENT OF BANKING'S RECOMMENDED CHANGES TO THE BANKING STATUTES CONCERNING FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS', to implement the Department of Banking's recommended changes to the banking statutes concerning financial institutions.

S.B. No. **849** (RAISED) BANKING. 'AN ACT IMPLEMENTING THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF BANKING CONCERNING CONSUMER CREDIT LICENSES', to implement the Department of Banking's recommended changes to banking statutes concerning consumer credit licenses.

COMMITTEE ON CHILDREN

H.B. No. **6399** (RAISED) COMMITTEE ON CHILDREN. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE CENTERS FOR DISEASE CONTROL AND PREVENTION YOUTH RISK BEHAVIOR SURVEY', to require the Department of Public Health to administer the national Youth Risk Behavior Survey and the Child Advocate to develop questions assessing the risk of youths becoming victims of sexual assault or misconduct by an adult.

PUBLIC SAFETY AND SECURITY. Proposed H.B. No. **6306** AN ACT CONCERNING 9-1-1 DISPATCHERS.

The bill was referred to the Committee on Labor and Public Employees.

PUBLIC HEALTH. Proposed H.B. No. **5398** AN ACT CONCERNING LOCAL HEALTH DEPARTMENT OR HEALTH DISTRICT FUNDING.

The bill was referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

PUBLIC HEALTH. Proposed H.B. No. **5407** AN ACT REQUIRING THE DISPENSING AND ADMINISTERING OF METHADONE TO BE REPORTED THROUGH THE ELECTRONIC PRESCRIPTION DRUG MONITORING PROGRAM.

The bill was referred to the Committee on Labor and Public Employees.
