"AN ACT CONCERNING IMMUNIZATIONS."

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. Subsection (b) of section 10-204a of the general statutes is
4 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from*
5 *passage*):

6 (b) The definitions of adequate immunization shall reflect the
7 schedule for active immunization adopted pursuant to section 19a-7f
8 and be established by regulation adopted in accordance with the
9 provisions of chapter 54 by the Commissioner of Public Health, who
10 shall also be responsible for providing procedures under which [said]
11 such boards and [said] similar governing bodies shall collect and report
12 immunization data on each child to the Department of Public Health for
13 compilation and analysis by said department. On or before January 1,
14 2022, the commissioner shall develop an electronic form to be used by
15 such boards and similar governing bodies to report such immunization

16 data to the department. Such electronic form shall include a section in
17 which said boards and similar governing bodies shall report (1) all
18 students who are noncompliant with the immunization requirements
19 set forth in subsection (a) of this section, and (2) whether such students
20 are in the process of receiving immunizations that will render them
21 compliant with such immunization requirements. "
