"AN ACT CONCERNING IMMUNIZATIONS."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (*Effective from passage*) On or before January 1, 2022, and
4 annually thereafter, the Commissioner of Public Health shall prepare an
5 annual report on adverse reactions to immunizations in the state. Such
6 report shall include, but need not be limited to, (1) the total number of
7 adverse reactions reported during the previous calendar year, (2)
8 reported adverse reactions, disaggregated by immunization type, lot
9 number and age of recipient, (3) the total number and cost of emergency
10 department visits related to the reported adverse reactions, (4) the total
11 number of hospitalizations, permanent disabilities and deaths related to
12 the reported adverse reactions, and (5) a summary of activities
13 undertaken by the Department of Public Health to support the state
14 filing for compensation pursuant to the National Childhood Vaccine

15 Injury Act of 1986, 42 USC 300aa-1 et seq. Such report shall be posted on
16 the department's Internet web site and shall be provided to all health
17 care practitioners who administer immunizations in the state."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
