"AN ACT CONCERNING IMMUNIZATIONS."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective January 1, 2022*) Notwithstanding any other
4 provision of the general statutes, no insurer, health care center, hospital
5 service corporation, medical service corporation, fraternal benefit
6 society or other entity that delivers, issues for delivery, renews, amends
7 or continues an individual or group health insurance policy in this state
8 on or after January 1, 2022, that provides coverage of the type specified
9 in subdivisions (1), (2), (4), (11), (12) and (16) of section 38a-469 of the
10 general statutes and includes coverage for prescription drugs shall
11 provide any financial incentive, including, but not limited to, any bonus
12 payment, to a health care provider for the purpose of incentivizing the
13 health care provider to administer a vaccine. Nothing in this section
14 shall prohibit a health care provider who administers a covered vaccine

15 to an insured under any such policy from seeking reimbursement under
16 such policy for the cost incurred by the health care provider in
17 administering such vaccine, or the insurer, health care center, hospital
18 service corporation, medical service corporation, fraternal benefit
19 society or other entity that delivered, issued for delivery, renewed,
20 amended or continued such policy from paying such reimbursement to
21 such health care provider under such policy."
