"AN ACT CONCERNING IMMUNIZATIONS."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) (a) As used in this section,
4 "COVID-19" means the respiratory disease designated by the World
5 Health Organization on February 11, 2020, as coronavirus 2019, and any
6 related mutation thereof recognized by said organization as a
7 communicable respiratory disease and "public official" means public
8 official as defined in section 1-79 of the general statutes.

9 (b) An employer shall not (1) require proof of the COVID-19
10 vaccination from employees, prospective employees, customers or
11 vendors, or (2) inquire into the COVID-19 vaccination records of
12 employees, prospective employees, customers or vendors.

13 (c) A public official shall not require proof of COVID-19 vaccination

14 for the use of state or municipal lands, parks or buildings."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
