**"AN ACT CONCERNING HUMAN TRAFFICKING."**

1 Strike lines 170 to 176, inclusive, in their entirety and substitute the  
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "(a) At any time after a court enters a judgment of conviction [is  
4 entered pursuant to section 53a-82] pursuant to section 53a-192a, as  
5 amended by this act, or for any misdemeanor offense or a class C, D or  
6 E felony or any unclassified felony offense carrying a term of  
7 imprisonment of not more than ten years, the defendant may apply to  
8 the Superior Court to vacate [any] such judgment of conviction on the  
9 basis that his or her participation in the offense was a result of having  
10 been a victim of conduct of another person that constitutes (1) trafficking  
11 in persons under section 53a-192a, as amended by this act, or (2) a  
12 criminal violation of 18 USC Chapter 77, as amended from time to time."
