**"AN ACT CONCERNING INCREASED OPPORTUNITIES FOR ABSENTEE VOTING, SAFE AND SECURE IN-PERSON VOTING, VOTER REGISTRATION AND CERTAIN OTHER CHANGES REGARDING ELECTION ADMINISTRATION."**

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1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Section 9-19j of the general statutes is amended by adding  
4 subsection (k) as follows (*Effective from passage*):

5 (k) (NEW) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsections (a) to (j),  
6 inclusive, of this section, no person may be admitted as an elector on  
7 election day or may be issued an election day registration ballot and  
8 election day registration envelope unless the state-wide centralized  
9 voter registration system described in section 9-50b, as amended by this  
10 act, is capable of, for each elector in the state, real-time tracking of  
11 registration and enrollment changes, when votes are cast at elections,  
12 primaries or referenda and when applications for absentee ballots have

13 been submitted.

14 Sec. 502. Subsection (a) of section 9-50b of the general statutes is  
15 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from*  
16 *passage*):

17 (a) As used in this section, "state-wide centralized voter registration  
18 system" means a computerized system designed and maintained by the  
19 Secretary of the State which includes: (1) Voter registration information  
20 prescribed by the Secretary, (2) information contained in applications  
21 for admission as electors described in section 9-20, as amended by this  
22 act, (3) information needed to compile registry lists and enrollment lists  
23 under sections 9-35 and 9-54, (4) information required by section 9-50a,  
24 (5) when electors have cast votes at elections, primaries or referenda, (6)  
25 when electors have submitted applications for absentee ballots, and [(5)]  
26 (7) other information for use in complying with the provisions of this  
27 title. In maintaining such system, the Secretary shall ensure that all  
28 information described in this subsection is updated in real time  
29 whenever changes are made to such information."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
