## "AN ACT CONCERNING POST-SECONDARY EDUCATION."

- Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the following in lieu thereof:
- 3 "Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) (a) There is established a task force
- 4 to study the efficacy of the system of governance for the Connecticut
- 5 State Colleges and Universities from the date the Board of Regents for
- 6 Higher Education was established until the present. Such study shall
- 7 include, but need not be limited to, an examination of the: (1) Students
- 8 First plan endorsed by said board, (2) measures for student success, (3)
- 9 administrative costs, (4) effectiveness of communication, governance
- and the establishment of budget priorities between said board and the
- 11 public institutions of higher education it governs, and (5) efficacy of
- 12 alternative systems of governance of public institutions of higher
- 13 education in other states.
- 14 (b) The task force shall consist of the following members:
- 15 (1) One appointed by the speaker of the House of Representatives,

16 who shall be a current member of the Board of Regents for Higher

- 18 (2) One appointed by the president pro tempore of the Senate, who
- 19 shall be a president of a state university within the Connecticut State
- 20 University System;
- 21 (3) One appointed by the majority leader of the House of
- 22 Representatives, who shall be a chief executive officer or president of a
- 23 regional community-technical college;
- 24 (4) One appointed by the majority leader of the Senate, who shall be
- 25 a faculty or staff member employed within the Connecticut State
- 26 University System;
- 27 (5) One appointed by the minority leader of the House of
- 28 Representatives, who shall be a current member of the Board of Regents
- 29 for Higher Education;
- 30 (6) One appointed by the minority leader of the Senate, who shall be
- a faculty or staff member employed within the regional community-
- 32 technical college system;
- 33 (7) The chairperson and vice-chairperson of the faculty advisory
- 34 committee established pursuant to section 10a-3a of the general statutes;
- 35 (8) Two appointed by the Connecticut State University American
- 36 Association of University Professors, who shall be faculty or staff
- 37 members employed within the Connecticut State University System;
- 38 (9) One appointed by the Congress of Connecticut Community
- 39 Colleges, who shall be a faculty or staff member employed within the
- 40 regional community-technical college system; and
- 41 (10) One appointed by the Connecticut affiliate of the American
- 42 Federation of Teachers, who shall be a faculty or staff member employed
- 43 within the regional community-technical college system.

(c) Any member of the task force appointed under subdivision (1), (2), (3), (4), (5) or (6) of subsection (b) of this section may be a member of the General Assembly.

- (d) All initial appointments to the task force shall be made not later than thirty days after the effective date of this section. Any vacancy shall be filled by the appointing authority.
  - (e) The chairperson of the task force shall be elected from among the members of the task force. Such chairperson shall schedule the first meeting of the task force, which shall be held not later than sixty days after the effective date of this section.
  - (f) The administrative staff of the joint standing committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to higher education shall serve as administrative staff of the task force.
  - (g) Not later than January 1, 2022, the task force shall submit a report on its findings and recommendations to the joint standing committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to higher education, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes. The task force shall terminate on the date that it submits such report or January 1, 2022, whichever is later."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
