"AN ACT CONCERNING A PROGRAM TO PROVIDE FREE SWIMMING LESSONS TO INDIVIDUALS UNDER THE AGE OF EIGHTEEN."

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) The Commissioner of Energy and
4 Environmental Protection shall conduct a study to determine the
5 feasibility of establishing and administering a program (1) to provide
6 free swimming lessons to children under the age of eighteen at not fewer
7 than eight state parks, (2) operating annually for the period beginning
8 the Friday before the last Monday in May and ending the first Monday
9 in September, and (3) for which establishment and administration the
10 commissioner is permitted to accept gifts, grants and donations, from
11 any source, public or private. Not later than January 1, 2022, the
12 commissioner shall submit a report, in accordance with the provisions
13 of section 11-4a of the general statutes, to the joint standing committees
14 of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to
15 children and the environment. Such report shall include, but not be

16 limited to, (A) analyses of the logistics of such program, associated costs
17 and staffing requirements, and (B) a copy of the most recent report
18 developed pursuant to subsection (c) of section 23-15b of the general
19 statutes, updated with additional data through December 1, 2021."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
