**"AN ACT CONCERNING THE DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF
THE COMMISSION ON HUMAN RIGHTS AND OPPORTUNITIES."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Subsection (b) of section 46a-101 of the general statutes is
4 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October*
5 *1, 2021*):

6 (b) The complainant [and] or the respondent, [by themselves or their
7 attorneys] or an attorney acting on behalf of the complainant or
8 respondent, may [jointly] request that the complainant receive a release
9 from the commission at any time from the date of filing the complaint.
10 [The complainant or the complainant's attorney may request a release
11 from the commission if the complaint is still pending after the expiration
12 of one hundred eighty days from the date of its filing or after a case
13 assessment review in accordance with subsection (c) of section 46a-83,

14 whichever is earlier.] The executive director or the executive director's
15 designee shall conduct an expedited case assessment review in
16 accordance with subsection (c) of section 46a-83 if the commission
17 receives a request for a release of jurisdiction from the complainant prior
18 to one hundred eighty days from the date a complaint is filed."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:		
Sec. 501	October 1, 2021	46a-101(b)
