"AN ACT CONCERNING THE OFFICE OF THE CORRECTION OMBUDS, THE USE OF ISOLATED CONFINEMENT, SECLUSION AND RESTRAINTS, SOCIAL CONTACTS FOR INCARCERATED PERSONS AND TRAINING AND WORKERS' COMPENSATION BENEFITS FOR CORRECTION OFFICERS."

1 Strike subdivision (8) of subsection (a) of section 2 and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "(8) "Isolated confinement" means confinement of an incarcerated
4 person in a cell, alone or with others, for more than nineteen hours per
5 day;"

6 Strike subdivisions (1) and (2) of subsection (b) of section 2 and insert
7 the following in lieu thereof:

8 "(b) (1) On and after July 1, 2022, each incarcerated person shall have

9 the opportunity to be outside of his or her cell for at least five hours each
10 day, except for those incarcerated persons on restrictive housing status,
11 or as otherwise provided in the case of an incarcerated person held in
12 seclusion pursuant to subsection (d) of this section or except as provided
13 in subdivision (4) of this subsection or in response to (A) a serious
14 incident resulting in a correctional facility-wide lockdown; (B) a
15 substantiated threat of imminent physical harm to another person as
16 evidenced by recent conduct; or (C) an incarcerated person's request for
17 segregation for such person's protection.

18 (2) On and after July 1, 2023, each incarcerated person shall have the
19 opportunity to be outside of his or her cell for at least five hours each
20 day, including those incarcerated persons on restrictive housing status,
21 except in the case of an incarcerated person held in seclusion pursuant
22 to subsection (d) of this section or except as provided in subdivision (4)
23 of this subsection or in response to (A) a serious incident resulting in a
24 correctional facility-wide lockdown; (B) a substantiated threat of
25 imminent physical harm to another person as evidenced by recent
26 conduct; or (C) an incarcerated person's request for segregation for such
27 person's protection."
