**"AN ACT CONCERNING RESPONSIBLE AND EQUITABLE
REGULATION OF ADULT-USE CANNABIS."**

1 Strike section 60 in its entirety and substitute the following in lieu
2 thereof:

3 "Sec. 60. (*Effective July 1, 2022*) Not later than January 1, 2023, the
4 department shall make written recommendations, in accordance with
5 the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes, to the Governor
6 and the joint standing committees of the General Assembly having
7 cognizance of matters relating to consumer protection, the judiciary and
8 finance, revenue and bonding, as to whether to continue allowing
9 consumers, who are twenty-one years of age and older, to cultivate
10 cannabis for the consumer's use. In making such recommendation, the
11 commissioner shall consider: (1) Reasonable precautions to ensure that
12 the plants are secure from unauthorized access or access by any
13 individual under twenty-one years of age; (2) the location where such
14 cannabis may be grown; (3) how other states allow home growing and
15 how such states are regulating personal cultivation; (4) if personal
16 cultivation in other states has improved access for consumers; and (5)
17 any other related public safety or regulatory issues the department
18 deems necessary."
