Proposed [H.B. No. 5001](#) REP. WINKLER, 56th DIST.; REP. DOUCETTE, 13th DIST. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE PENSION AND ANNUITY INCOME DEDUCTION FROM THE PERSONAL INCOME TAX AND THE QUALIFYING INCOME THRESHOLD FOR MARRIED INDIVIDUALS FILING JOINTLY', to increase the qualifying income threshold for the pension and annuity income deduction from the personal income tax for married individuals filing jointly, to twice the amount of the qualifying income threshold for an unmarried individual.

REF. FINANCE, REVENUE AND BONDING

Proposed [H.B. No. 5002](#) REP. ZUPKUS, 89th DIST. 'AN ACT CONCERNING A GRACE PERIOD FOR TAXPAYERS TO CORRECT PAYMENT PROCESSING PROBLEMS', to establish a grace period for taxpayers to address a payment processing problem for taxes owed without incurring a penalty.

REF. FINANCE, REVENUE AND BONDING

Proposed [H.B. No. 5003](#) REP. PISCOPO, 76th DIST. 'AN ACT AUTHORIZING BONDS OF THE STATE FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A WATER LINE ON JACKSON STREET IN THE TOWN OF THOMASTON', to construct a water line on Jackson Street in Thomaston.

REF. FINANCE, REVENUE AND BONDING

Proposed [H.B. No. 5004](#) REP. CONLEY, 40th DIST. 'AN ACT EXEMPTING BREASTFEEDING SUPPLIES FROM THE SALES AND USE TAXES', to exempt breastfeeding supplies from the sales and use taxes.

REF. FINANCE, REVENUE AND BONDING

Proposed [H.B. No. 5005](#) REP. DELNICKI, 14th DIST. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE WAIVER OF INTEREST LEVIED ON DELINQUENT PROPERTY TAXES', to allow municipalities to waive the eighteen per cent interest levied on delinquent property taxes.

REF. FINANCE, REVENUE AND BONDING

Proposed [H.B. No. 5006](#) REP. LANOUE, 45th DIST.; SEN. SOMERS, 18th DIST. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE USE OF FUNDS IN THE CONNECTICUT LAKES, RIVERS AND PONDS PRESERVATION ACCOUNT', to establish clear requirements for priority funding to combat aquatic invasive species within Connecticut lakes, rivers and ponds.

REF. ENVIRONMENT

Proposed [H.B. No. 5007](#) REP. PISCOPO, 76th DIST. 'AN ACT WITHDRAWING CONNECTICUT FROM THE AGREEMENT AMONG THE STATES TO ELECT THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES BY NATIONAL POPULAR VOTE', to withdraw the state from the Agreement Among the States to Elect the President of the United States by National Popular Vote.

Proposed [H.B. No. 5008](#) REP. PISCOPO, 76th DIST. 'AN ACT ELIMINATING ELECTION DAY REGISTRATION', to eliminate election day registration.

Proposed [H.B. No. 5009](#) REP. MICHEL, 146th DIST. 'AN ACT CONCERNING ELECTORAL PRIVILEGES OF CERTAIN INCARCERATED INDIVIDUALS AND PAROLEES', to provide for restoration of electoral privileges to individuals incarcerated as a result of felonies of certain classifications and retention of such privileges by individuals who may be so incarcerated in the future, as well as to restore the electoral privileges of convicted felons who are on parole.

REF. GOVERNMENT ADMINISTRATION AND ELECTIONS

Proposed [H.B. No. 5010](#) REP. LANOUE, 45th DIST. 'AN ACT LIMITING THE NUMBER OF STATE AGENCY REGULATIONS', to reduce the regulatory burden on our state's businesses and residents by limiting the number of state agency regulations.

REF. GOVERNMENT ADMINISTRATION AND ELECTIONS

Proposed [H.B. No. 5011](#) REP. WINKLER, 56th DIST. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE COPYING OF PUBLIC RECORDS UNDER THE FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT', to reduce the fee for copying public records and provide no fee for copying records with a camera, cell phone or portable scanner.

REF. GOVERNMENT ADMINISTRATION AND ELECTIONS

Proposed [H.B. No. 5012](#) REP. LANOUE, 45th DIST. 'AN ACT PROPORTIONALLY AWARDING THE STATE'S ELECTORAL COLLEGE VOTES FOR PRESIDENT AND VICE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES', to more proportionally award Connecticut's Electoral College votes.

REF. GOVERNMENT ADMINISTRATION AND ELECTIONS

Proposed [H.B. No. 5013](#) REP. PAVALOCK-D'AMATO, 77th DIST. 'AN ACT CONCERNING MANDATED HEALTH INSURANCE BENEFIT REVIEW', to alter the manner in which the General Assembly enacts new mandated health insurance benefits.

REF. INSURANCE AND REAL ESTATE

Proposed [H.B. No. 5014](#) REP. MICHEL, 146th DIST. 'AN ACT REQUIRING DATA REPORTING TO ENSURE COMPLIANCE WITH FEDERAL LAW CONCERNING PARITY OF BENEFITS FOR PHYSICAL AND MENTAL HEALTH CARE SERVICES', to use data reporting to support parity of benefits for physical and mental health services.

REF. INSURANCE AND REAL ESTATE

Proposed [H.B. No. 5015](#) REP. MICHEL, 146th DIST. 'AN ACT CONCERNING PEER SUPPORT SPECIALISTS AND REQUIRING HEALTH INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR OUTPATIENT PEER SUPPORT SERVICES PROVIDED BY CERTIFIED PEER SUPPORT SPECIALISTS', to require: (1) The Commissioner of Public Health to adopt regulations (A) providing for the certification and education of peer support specialists, and (B) specifying the peer support services that a certified peer support specialist may provide to another individual in this state; and (2) health insurance coverage for peer support services provided by certified peer support specialists on an outpatient basis.

REF. INSURANCE AND REAL ESTATE

Proposed [H.B. No. 5016](#) REP. CONLEY, 40th DIST. 'AN ACT EXCLUDING BEER MANUFACTURERS, THEIR EMPLOYEES AND THE DEPENDENTS OF THEIR EMPLOYEES FROM VARIOUS PROVISIONS OF THE INSURANCE STATUTES CONCERNING SMALL EMPLOYER HEALTH INSURANCE COVERAGE', to exclude beer manufacturers, their employees and the dependents of their employees from various provisions of the insurance statutes concerning small employer health insurance coverage.

REF. INSURANCE AND REAL ESTATE

Proposed [H.B. No. 5017](#) REP. CARNEY, 23rd DIST. 'AN ACT REQUIRING HEALTH INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR GENETIC CYSTIC FIBROSIS SCREENINGS FOR WOMEN', to require health insurance coverage for genetic cystic fibrosis screenings for women.

REF. INSURANCE AND REAL ESTATE

Proposed [H.B. No. 5018](#) REP. VARGAS, 6th DIST. 'AN ACT RESTRICTING REGISTERED SEX OFFENDERS FROM THE VICINITY OF A SCHOOL BUS STOP', to prevent opportunities for registered sex offenders to engage with students at school bus stops.

REF. JUDICIARY

Proposed [H.B. No. 5019](#) REP. CONLEY, 40th DIST. 'AN ACT PROHIBITING THE OFFERING OF SLEEPING ACCOMMODATIONS AT HOTELS, MOTELS OR SIMILAR LODGINGS AT AN HOURLY RATE AND REQUIRING THAT USERS OF SUCH PLACES OF PUBLIC ACCOMMODATION PROVIDE THE OPERATOR WITH POSITIVE PROOF OF IDENTIFICATION', to protect victims of sex trafficking and enhance the ability of law enforcement personnel to apprehend and prosecute individuals who promote sex trafficking.

REF. JUDICIARY

Proposed [H.B. No. 5020](#) REP. LABRIOLA, 131st DIST. 'AN ACT CONCERNING HOLDERS OF COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S LICENSES AND ELIGIBILITY TO PARTICIPATE IN PRETRIAL ALCOHOL EDUCATION PROGRAMS', to allow holders of commercial driver's licenses to participate in alcohol education programming under certain circumstances.

REF. JUDICIARY

Proposed [H.B. No. 5021](#) REP. CASE, 63rd DIST. 'AN ACT ELIMINATING THE REQUIREMENT THAT A REAL ESTATE CLOSING BE CONDUCTED BY AN ATTORNEY WHO IS LICENSED AND IN GOOD STANDING IN THIS STATE', to eliminate the requirement that a real estate closing be conducted by an attorney who is licensed and in good standing in this state.

REF. JUDICIARY

Proposed [H.B. No. 5022](#) REP. ZUPKUS, 89th DIST. 'AN ACT LIMITING THE DURATION OF A RENEWAL OF THE DECLARATION OF A PUBLIC HEALTH OR CIVIL PREPAREDNESS EMERGENCY DURING A PANDEMIC', to limit the duration of a renewal of the declaration of a public health or civil preparedness emergency during a pandemic to not longer than a month.

REF. PUBLIC HEALTH

Proposed [H.B. No. 5023](#) REP. KLARIDES-DITRIA, 105th DIST. 'AN ACT CONCERNING IMMUNITY FROM ARREST FOR POSSESSION OF ALCOHOL BY A MINOR WHEN A PERSON UNDER TWENTY-ONE YEARS OF AGE SEEKS ASSISTANCE FOR POSSIBLE ALCOHOL POISONING', to save lives by encouraging minors to seek medical assistance for alcohol poisoning.

REF. PUBLIC HEALTH

Proposed [H.B. No. 5024](#) REP. KLARIDES-DITRIA, 105th DIST. 'AN ACT CONCERNING SURGICAL SMOKE IN THE OPERATING ROOM', to require hospitals and outpatient surgical facilities to adopt and implement a policy to prevent human exposure to surgical smoke through the use of a surgical smoke evacuation system.

REF. PUBLIC HEALTH

Proposed [H.B. No. 5025](#) REP. NUCCIO, 53rd DIST. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE STATE DENTAL COMMISSION', to include a dental hygienist on the State Dental Commission.

REF. PUBLIC HEALTH

Proposed [H.B. No. 5026](#) REP. ZUPKUS, 89th DIST. 'AN ACT DESIGNATING A PORTION OF ROUTES 68 AND 70 IN CHESHIRE AS A BIKEWAY', to designate a portion of a roadway in Cheshire as a bikeway in accordance with the Department of Transportation's Active Transportation Plan.

REF. TRANSPORTATION

Proposed [H.J. No. 1](#) REP. PETIT, 22nd DIST. 'RESOLUTION PROPOSING A STATE CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT CONCERNING TERM LIMITS FOR LEGISLATORS', to establish term limits for legislators.

REF. GOVERNMENT ADMINISTRATION AND ELECTIONS
