[H.B. No. 5013](#) (COMM) INSURANCE AND REAL ESTATE. 'AN ACT CONCERNING MANDATED HEALTH INSURANCE BENEFIT REVIEW', to alter the manner in which the General Assembly enacts new mandated health insurance benefits.

REF. INSURANCE AND REAL ESTATE

[H.B. No. 5412](#) (COMM) PUBLIC SAFETY AND SECURITY. 'AN ACT NAMING THE TROOP K STATE POLICE BARRACKS IN COLCHESTER IN HONOR OF LINDA A. ORANGE', to name the Troop K State Police Barracks in honor of late State Representative Linda A. Orange.

REF. PUBLIC SAFETY AND SECURITY

[H.B. No. 6384](#) (RAISED) ENVIRONMENT. 'AN ACT CONCERNING AQUATIC INVASIVE SPECIES' EFFECTS ON LAKES AND RELATED FUNDING', to examine, address and decrease the effects of invasive aquatic species on the state's lakes.

REF. ENVIRONMENT

[H.B. No. 6385](#) (RAISED) ENVIRONMENT. 'AN ACT CONCERNING ENHANCEMENTS TO CERTAIN AGRICULTURAL PROGRAMS', to (1) include chicken eggs as part of the state-funded Connecticut Farmers' Market/WIC and Senior Nutrition programs, (2) increase fines for violating certain farm product grading and marketing requirements, (3) provide the Commissioner of Agriculture with infraction authority for the violation of statutes under the commissioner's authority, and (4) increase vouchers for said nutrition programs.

[H.B. No. 6386](#) (RAISED) ENVIRONMENT. 'AN ACT CONCERNING EXTENDED PRODUCER RESPONSIBILITY FOR TIRES, SMOKE DETECTORS AND CERTAIN GAS CYLINDERS', to manage and divert items such as tires, smoke detectors and gas cylinders within the state's solid waste stream.

REF. ENVIRONMENT

H.B. No. 6387 (RAISED) INSURANCE AND REAL ESTATE. 'AN ACT CONCERNING INSURANCE DISCRIMINATION AGAINST LIVING ORGAN DONORS', to: (1) Prohibit certain insurers from engaging in certain discrimination against living organ donors; and (2) provide that prohibited discrimination against living organ donors constitutes a violation of the Connecticut Unfair Insurance Practices Act.

REF. INSURANCE AND REAL ESTATE

H.B. No. 6388 (RAISED) INSURANCE AND REAL ESTATE. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE INSURANCE DEPARTMENT'S RECOMMENDATIONS REGARDING CAPTIVE INSURANCE COMPANIES', to: (1) Amend certain definitions concerning captive insurance companies; (2) provide tax amnesty to an insured that establishes a branch captive insurance company in, or transfers the domicile of its alien captive insurance company or foreign captive insurance company to, this state; (3) modify the licensing requirements for certain captive insurance companies; (4) modify the capitalization requirements for certain captive insurance companies; (5) authorize the commissioner to exempt certain branch captive insurance companies from minimum capitalization requirements; (6) authorize foreign captive insurance companies to register to do business in this state; (7) modify the annual financial reporting requirements applicable to captive insurance companies; (8) authorize the commissioner to (A) waive the annual financial reporting requirement for certain alien captive insurance companies and foreign captive insurance companies, (B) less frequently examine the financial condition of captive insurance companies, (C) waive the periodic financial examination of pure captive insurance companies, and (D) adopt additional regulations concerning certain captive insurance companies; (9) provide that a captive insurance company may assume reinsurance from any other insurer regardless of whether such reinsurance is for risks that the captive insurance company is authorized to write directly; and (10) extend the term of certificates of dormancy issued to captive insurance companies and modify the requirements applicable to dormant captive insurance companies.

REF. INSURANCE AND REAL ESTATE

H.B. No. 6389 (RAISED) INSURANCE AND REAL ESTATE. 'AN ACT CONCERNING EXPLANATIONS OF BENEFITS', to: (1) Require health insurers that deliver, issue for delivery, renew, amend or continue certain health insurance policies in this state to (A) issue explanations of benefits to consumers in certain circumstances, and (B) disclose information concerning explanations of benefits to consumers; and (2) require that explanations of benefits be maintained as confidential in certain circumstances.

H.B. No. 6390 (RAISED) INSURANCE AND REAL ESTATE. 'AN ACT CONCERNING HEALTH INSURANCE REIMBURSEMENT PARITY FOR PODIATRISTS', to provide that a health insurer shall not pay a reduced reimbursement to a licensed health care provider who provides a covered benefit within the provider's scope of practice solely because the provider is a podiatrist.

H.B. No. 6391 (RAISED) INSURANCE AND REAL ESTATE. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE INSURANCE DEPARTMENT'S RECOMMENDATIONS REGARDING THE GENERAL STATUTES', to: (1) Modify reporting requirements, and impose a late filing fee and penalty, concerning the public health fee; (2) eliminate an annual report from the Insurance Commissioner to the joint standing committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to insurance concerning (A) fires and explosions caused by arson, (B) the workers' compensation fraud unit within the office of the Chief State's Attorney, (C) motor vehicle insurance fraud, and (D) health insurance fraud; (3) modify the Insurance Data Security Law; (4) modify the payment schedule for assessments against domestic insurance companies and other domestic entities; and (5) modify the procedures governing external and expedited external reviews of adverse determinations and final adverse determinations.

REF. INSURANCE AND REAL ESTATE

H.B. No. 6392 (RAISED) INSURANCE AND REAL ESTATE. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE INSURANCE DEPARTMENT'S RECOMMENDATIONS REGARDING CREDIT FOR REINSURANCE', to adopt the Insurance Department's recommendations regarding credit for reinsurance.

REF. INSURANCE AND REAL ESTATE

H.B. No. 6393 (RAISED) INSURANCE AND REAL ESTATE. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE INSURANCE DEPARTMENT'S RECOMMENDATIONS REGARDING SURETY BAIL BOND AGENTS', to: (1) Automatically cancel a surety bail bond agent's license if the agent does not pay an annual examination fee; (2) reschedule an annual transfer to the General Fund from the surety bail bond agent examination account; and (3) authorize the Insurance Commissioner to adopt regulations concerning continuing education requirements for surety bail bond agents.

REF. INSURANCE AND REAL ESTATE

H.B. No. 6394 (RAISED) PUBLIC SAFETY AND SECURITY. 'AN ACT CONCERNING INTEREST ON LOTTERY SALES AGENT DELINQUENCY ASSESSMENTS', to (1) specify that simple interest is charged on delinquency assessments of lottery sales agents, and (2) allow an agent whose delinquency assessment remains due and was subject to compounding interest to request a hardship waiver from the Commissioner of Consumer Protection to recalculate the interest owed.

H.B. No. 6395 (RAISED) PUBLIC SAFETY AND SECURITY. 'AN ACT CONCERNING SMALL HOT WATER HEATERS', to exempt small hot water heaters from the provisions of chapter 540 of the general statutes.
