H.B. No. 5761 (COMM) COMMERCE. 'AN ACT ESTABLISHING A REGULATORY SANDBOX PROGRAM', to establish a regulatory sandbox program, which allows a person to temporarily test an innovative product or service on a limited basis without otherwise being licensed or authorized to act by the laws of this state.

REF. COMMERCE

H.B. No. 6409 (RAISED) ENERGY AND TECHNOLOGY. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE SOLICITATION OF BIOGAS INJECTION PROPOSALS FROM ANAEROBIC DIGESTION FACILITIES', to solicit proposals from anaerobic digestion facilities that produce biogas for injection into the natural gas distribution system in the state.

REF. ENERGY AND TECHNOLOGY

H.B. No. 6410 (RAISED) ENERGY AND TECHNOLOGY. 'AN ACT INCREASING THE PENALTY FOR VIOLATIONS ASSOCIATED WITH THE NO SALES SOLICITATION CALLS LISTING', to increase the penalty applicable to telephone solicitors for violations associated with the no sales solicitation calls listing.

REF. ENERGY AND TECHNOLOGY

H.B. No. 6411 (RAISED) ENERGY AND TECHNOLOGY. 'AN ACT MOVING THE OFFICE OF CONSUMER COUNSEL WITHIN THE OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL', to relocate the Office of Consumer Counsel within the office of the Attorney General.

REF. ENERGY AND TECHNOLOGY

H.B. No. 6412 (RAISED) ENERGY AND TECHNOLOGY. 'AN ACT CONCERNING A LOW-CARBON FUEL BLEND OF HEATING OIL AND THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A BIOHEAT ADVISORY BOARD', to require a low-carbon fuel blend of heating oil in the state and to establish a Bioheat Advisory Board.

REF. ENERGY AND TECHNOLOGY

H.B. No. 6413 (RAISED) ENERGY AND TECHNOLOGY. 'AN ACT REQUIRING A STUDY OF A MUNICIPAL ENERGY SECURITY AUTHORITY', to require the Commissioner of Energy and Environmental Protection to study whether to recognize a Municipal Energy Security Authority in the state.

REF. ENERGY AND TECHNOLOGY

H.B. No. 6414 (RAISED) ENERGY AND TECHNOLOGY. 'AN ACT REQUIRING THE STUDY OF THE USE OF TECHNOLOGY IN THE STATE', to require the Commissioner of Energy and Environmental Protection to conduct a study to determine whether policy and procedural changes within the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection may increase the effectiveness of the use of technology in the state.

REF. ENERGY AND TECHNOLOGY

H.B. No. 6415 (RAISED) ENERGY AND TECHNOLOGY. 'AN ACT REQUIRING THE PUBLIC UTILITIES REGULATORY AUTHORITY TO ADOPT REGULATIONS FOR NATURAL BARRIER PRESERVATION AND MAINTENANCE BY ELECTRIC DISTRIBUTION COMPANIES', to require the Public Utilities Regulatory Authority to adopt regulations ensuring electric distribution companies preserve and maintain existing natural barriers.

REF. ENERGY AND TECHNOLOGY

H.B. No. 6416 (RAISED) HUMAN SERVICES. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE REMOVAL OF LIENS ON THE PROPERTY OF PUBLIC ASSISTANCE BENEFICIARIES', to eliminate state recovery of public assistance payments from assets and estates valued at two hundred fifty thousand dollars or less except as required under federal law.

REF. HUMAN SERVICES

H.B. No. 6417 (RAISED) COMMITTEE ON CHILDREN. 'AN ACT REQUIRING BACKGROUND CHECKS FOR CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF YOUTH CAMPS', to require youth camp employees who are eighteen years of age or older to submit to a comprehensive background check.

REF. COMMITTEE ON CHILDREN

H.B. No. 6418 (RAISED) PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT. 'AN ACT CONCERNING ABANDONED AND BLIGHTED PROPERTY RECEIVERSHIP', to remove the municipal population threshold for certain parties to petition the Superior Court for appointment of a receiver for a blighted and abandoned property.

REF. PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT

H.B. No. 6419 (RAISED) PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT. 'AN ACT CONCERNING VOTING REQUIREMENTS FOR ESTABLISHING A DISTRICT TO MAINTAIN WATER QUALITY IN A LAKE OR LAKES', to allow a simple majority of voters to approve the creation of a special taxing district to maintain water quality in a lake.

REF. PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT

H.B. No. 6420 (RAISED) PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTION FOR CERTAIN MUNICIPAL VOLUNTEERS', to increase the property tax exemption for certain municipal volunteers from one thousand dollars to two thousand dollars.

REF. PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT

H.B. No. 6421 (RAISED) PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE CONTINUATION OF RETIREMENT ALLOWANCES FOR CERTAIN RETIREES UPON SUBSEQUENT EMPLOYMENT BY A BOARD OF EDUCATION', to permit retired public safety personnel to receive retirement allowances, but not credit in a municipal pension system, if such personnel are employed by a local or regional board of education in a public safety capacity after retirement.

REF. PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT

H.B. No. 6422 (RAISED) PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT. 'AN ACT REQUIRING A STUDY OF THE OBSTACLES TO MERGING OR CONSOLIDATING MUNICIPAL FIRE DISTRICTS AND FIRE DEPARTMENTS', to require the Secretary of the Office of Policy and Management to conduct a study regarding the obstacles to merging or consolidating the fire districts or fire departments of two or more municipalities.

H.B. No. 6423 (RAISED) PUBLIC HEALTH. 'AN ACT CONCERNING IMMUNIZATIONS', to protect the public health by ensuring adequate and appropriate immunizations of children.

REF. PUBLIC HEALTH

H.B. No. 6424 (RAISED) PUBLIC HEALTH. 'AN ACT REVISING DATA COLLECTION REQUIREMENTS FOR HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS CONNECTING TO THE STATE-WIDE HEALTH INFORMATION EXCHANGE', to clarify and standardize race, ethnicity and language data collection for health care providers required to connect to the State-wide Health Information Exchange.

REF. PUBLIC HEALTH

H.B. No. 6425 (RAISED) PUBLIC HEALTH. 'AN ACT CONCERNING AID IN DYING FOR TERMINALLY ILL PATIENTS', to provide aid in dying to terminally ill patients.

REF. PUBLIC HEALTH

H.B. No. 6426 (RAISED) TRANSPORTATION. 'AN ACT CONCERNING RECOMMENDATIONS BY THE CONNECTICUT AIRPORT AUTHORITY REGARDING THE PROVISION OF SECURITY SERVICES AND METEOROLOGICAL EVALUATION TOWERS', to (1) require the Connecticut Airport Authority and the Department of Emergency Services and Public Protection to enter into a contract for security services at Bradley International Airport, and (2) establish safety standards for meteorological evaluation towers.

REF. TRANSPORTATION

H.B. No. 6427 (RAISED) VETERANS' AFFAIRS. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE ORGANIZATIONAL STRUCTURE AND BYLAWS OF THE MILITIA UNITS', to require the Governor to determine the structure of the militia units and authorize the Adjutant General to issue bylaws, regulations, orders and circulars for the militia.

REF. VETERANS' AFFAIRS

H.B. No. 6428 (RAISED) VETERANS' AFFAIRS. 'AN ACT ESTABLISHING A LAW ENFORCEMENT SUPPORT OFFICE PROGRAM ACCOUNT', to establish a law enforcement support office program account.

REF. VETERANS' AFFAIRS

H.B. No. 6429 (RAISED) VETERANS' AFFAIRS. 'AN ACT ESTABLISHING A TASK FORCE TO STUDY THE EXPANSION OF PROPERTY TAX RELIEF FOR CERTAIN VETERANS', to establish a task force to study the feasibility of expanding property tax relief for certain veterans, and the fiscal impact on municipalities of any such expanded tax relief.

REF. VETERANS' AFFAIRS

H.B. No. 6430 (RAISED) HOUSING. 'AN ACT CONCERNING HOUSING AUTHORITY JURISDICTION', to allow a housing authority to expand its jurisdiction to include certain high and very high opportunity areas, as determined by the Department of Housing.

REF. HOUSING

H.B. No. 6431 (RAISED) HOUSING. 'AN ACT CONCERNING HOUSING OPPORTUNITIES FOR JUSTICE-IMPACTED PERSONS', to prohibit housing providers from considering a prospective tenant's criminal conviction after certain time periods.

REF. HOUSING

H.B. No. 6432 (RAISED) HOUSING. 'AN ACT CONCERNING HOUSING AUTHORITY APPLICATION PROCEDURES', to simplify the application process for assisted housing.

REF. HOUSING

H.B. No. 6433 (RAISED) HOUSING. 'AN ACT CONCERNING INSPECTIONS OF RENTAL PROPERTY PRIOR TO OCCUPANCY OR TERMINATION, LATE RENTAL PAYMENTS AND DESIGNATION OF A RENTAL HOUSING OMBUDSMAN', to permit tenants to request an inspection of rental property prior to occupancy and after notice of termination of a tenancy, to cap late fees for rental payments and to create a Rental Housing Ombudsman within the Department of Housing.

H.B. No. 6434 (RAISED) COMMERCE. 'AN ACT CONCERNING MANUFACTURER NEEDS IN THE STATE', to require the Commissioner of Economic and Community Development to study the needs of manufacturers in the state.

REF. COMMERCE

H.B. No. 6435 (RAISED) COMMERCE. 'AN ACT EXTENDING THE MANUFACTURING APPRENTICESHIP TAX CREDIT TO PASS-THROUGH ENTITIES', to allow pass-through entities to claim the manufacturing apprenticeship tax credit against the personal income tax or the affected business entity tax.

H.B. No. 6436 (RAISED) HOUSING. 'AN ACT ESTABLISHING THE OPEN CHOICE VOUCHERS PILOT PROGRAM', to establish a pilot program to enable certain families participating in the interdistrict public school attendance program to move to the town where their children attend school.

REF. HOUSING

H.B. No. 6437 (RAISED) HOUSING. 'AN ACT REQUIRING LANDLORDS TO NOTIFY TENANTS OF FORECLOSURE PROCEEDINGS', to require landlords to notify prospective and current tenants of foreclosure proceedings and to permit tenants to seek court appointment of a receiver upon receiving such notice.
