S.B. No. 853 (RAISED) HUMAN SERVICES. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE STATE-WIDE HEALTH INFORMATION EXCHANGE BOARD OF DIRECTORS', to add the Commissioner of Social Services, or the commissioner's designee, to the State-Wide Health Information Exchange Board of Directors.

REF. HUMAN SERVICES

S.B. No. 854 (RAISED) HUMAN SERVICES. 'AN ACT CONCERNING A LIST OF THE 100 MOST DELINQUENT CHILD SUPPORT OBLIGORS', to eliminate a requirement that a list of delinquent child support obligors be published.

REF. HUMAN SERVICES

S.B. No. 855 (RAISED) ENERGY AND TECHNOLOGY. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE DECOUPLING OF THE PUBLIC UTILITIES REGULATORY AUTHORITY AND THE DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY AND ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION', to decouple the Public Utilities Regulatory Authority and the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection.

REF. ENERGY AND TECHNOLOGY

S.B. No. 856 (RAISED) ENERGY AND TECHNOLOGY. 'AN ACT INCREASING REPRESENTATION ON THE ENERGY CONSERVATION MANAGEMENT BOARD', to increase representation on the energy conservation management board, including low-income residential customers and municipalities.

REF. ENERGY AND TECHNOLOGY

S.B. No. 857 (RAISED) ENERGY AND TECHNOLOGY. 'AN ACT CONCERNING EMERGENCY BACKUP POWER FOR CELL TOWERS', to require a telecommunications company to provide backup power for free-standing telecommunications towers or antennas.

REF. ENERGY AND TECHNOLOGY

S.B. No. 858 (RAISED) ENERGY AND TECHNOLOGY. 'AN ACT CONCERNING CALL BEFORE YOU DIG PROGRAM VIOLATIONS AND CERTAIN MODIFICATIONS TO GAS PIPELINES PROCESSES', to require that civil penalties for the failure of a public utility to properly or timely mark the approximate location of an underground facility be paid by the person, public agency or public utility to whom the notice of failure to comply is addressed; and to modify existing gas pipeline processes.

REF. ENERGY AND TECHNOLOGY

S.B. No. 859 (RAISED) VETERANS' AFFAIRS. 'AN ACT CONCERNING CERTAIN DEPOSITS IN THE DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS' INSTITUTIONAL GENERAL WELFARE FUND', to require the deposit of reimbursements from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs for pharmaceutical purchases into the institutional general welfare fund.

REF. VETERANS' AFFAIRS

S.B. No. 860 (RAISED) VETERANS' AFFAIRS. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE USE OF MEDICAID, MEDICARE AND TRICARE FUNDS TO PROVIDE CERTAIN VETERANS WITH TRANSPORTATION TO MEDICAL APPOINTMENTS', to provide veterans who do not have access to transportation with transportation services to and from medical appointments and hospital visits.

REF. VETERANS' AFFAIRS

S.B. No. 861 (RAISED) VETERANS' AFFAIRS. 'AN ACT WAIVING CERTAIN MEDICAL MARIJUANA FEES FOR VETERANS', to exempt veterans from the registration and administration fees for medical marijuana.

REF. VETERANS' AFFAIRS

S.B. No. 862 (RAISED) ENERGY AND TECHNOLOGY. 'AN ACT LIMITING ELIGIBILITY FOR THE RESIDENTIAL SOLAR INVESTMENT PROGRAM AND PREVENTING DISTRIBUTED ENERGY GENERATION SOLICITATIONS FROM SEGREGATING LARGE PROJECTS', to limit eligibility for the Residential Solar Investment Program, and to prevent renewable energy solicitations from segregating a large project into smaller projects.

REF. ENERGY AND TECHNOLOGY

S.B. No. 863 (RAISED) ENERGY AND TECHNOLOGY. 'AN ACT CONCERNING ENERGY EFFICIENCY STANDARDS', to establish and update state appliance and equipment energy and water efficiency standards.

REF. ENERGY AND TECHNOLOGY

S.B. No. 864 (RAISED) ENERGY AND TECHNOLOGY. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE VALUATION OF CERTAIN PROPERTIES FOR MUNICIPAL PURCHASE', to provide a value for the municipal purchase of substations and utility poles.

REF. ENERGY AND TECHNOLOGY

S.B. No. 865 (RAISED) ENERGY AND TECHNOLOGY. 'AN ACT REQUIRING THE STUDY OF ENERGY SOURCES', to require the Commissioner of Energy and Environmental Protection to conduct a study to determine whether policy and procedural changes within the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection may increase the effectiveness of energy sources utilized by the state.

REF. ENERGY AND TECHNOLOGY

S.B. No. 866 (RAISED) TRANSPORTATION. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE CONNECTICUT PORT AUTHORITY', to require the annual report submitted by the board of directors of the Connecticut Port Authority to include a summary of the authority's activities and recommendations for legislation to promote the authority's purpose.

REF. TRANSPORTATION

S.B. No. 867 (RAISED) PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT. 'AN ACT CONCERNING INVESTMENT OF CERTAIN MUNICIPAL FUNDS', to allow for the investment of funds held in certain trusts established by municipalities, or in which municipalities may participate, to be invested in trust funds administered, held or invested by the Treasurer.

REF. PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT

S.B. No. 868 (RAISED) PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT. 'AN ACT CONCERNING REGULATION OF COMMUNITY RESIDENCES', to distinguish certain facilities from community residences for the purposes of certain zoning statutes.

REF. PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT

S.B. No. 869 (RAISED) PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT. 'AN ACT CONCERNING COMMUNITY INVESTMENT BOARDS AND NEIGHBORHOOD ASSISTANCE', to (1) require certain municipalities to establish community investment boards to identify priorities for the use of municipal revenue sharing grants and select grants for payment in lieu of taxes, (2) require the Office of Policy and Management to accept proposals for solutions to problems specific to urban areas and establish pilot programs to implement such proposals, and (3) establish a task force to study issues concerning nonprofit providers.

REF. PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT

S.B. No. 870 (RAISED) PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE OFFICE OF POLICY AND MANAGEMENT', to implement the recommendations of the Office of Policy and Management concerning property tax exemptions, special taxing districts, neglected cemeteries, revaluation of real property, property tax assessment and appeals, regional services grants, tax overpayment refunds, tax collection and the elimination of municipal requirements relating to fiscal disparities.

REF. PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT

S.B. No. 871 (RAISED) COMMITTEE ON CHILDREN. 'AN ACT ESTABLISHING THE OFFICE OF THE DEPARTMENT OF CHILDREN AND FAMILIES OMBUDSMAN', to establish the Office of the Department of Children and Families Ombudsman within the Office of Governmental Accountability.

REF. COMMITTEE ON CHILDREN

S.B. No. 872 (RAISED) COMMITTEE ON CHILDREN. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE DEPARTMENT OF CHILDREN AND FAMILIES RECOMMENDATIONS FOR REVISIONS TO THE STATUTES CONCERNING CHILDREN', to make minor revisions to the statutes of the Department of Children and Families, to consolidate the reporting requirements of the department and to add a member to the State Advisory Council on Children and Families.

REF. COMMITTEE ON CHILDREN

S.B. No. 873 (RAISED) FINANCE, REVENUE AND BONDING. 'AN ACT MITIGATING ADVERSE TAX CONSEQUENCES RESULTING FROM EMPLOYEES WORKING REMOTELY DURING COVID-19, AND CONCERNING THE REMOVAL OF LIENS ON THE PROPERTY OF PUBLIC ASSISTANCE BENEFICIARIES AND A THREE-TIERED GRANTS IN LIEU OF TAXES PROGRAM', to (1) mitigate adverse tax consequences resulting from employees working remotely during the taxable year 2020 due to COVID-19, (2) eliminate state recovery of public assistance payments from certain assets and estates, and (3) revise the calculation of the amounts of grants in lieu of taxes paid to municipalities, based on equalized net grand list per capita.
