S.B. No. 5 (COMM) **GOVERNMENT ADMINISTRATION AND ELECTIONS. 'AN ACT CONCERNING INCREASED OPPORTUNITIES FOR ABSENTEE VOTING, SAFE AND SECURE IN-PERSON VOTING AND VOTER REGISTRATION'**, to make several changes to election laws designed to increase opportunities for absentee voting, safe and secure in-person voting and voter registration.

S.B. No. 167 (COMM) **COMMERCE. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE DISPOSITION OF THE FORMER SEASIDE SANATORIUM FACILITY'**, to require the Commissioner of Energy and Environmental Protection to issue a request for information for low-impact, residential uses for the former Seaside Sanatorium Facility in the town of Waterford.

S.B. No. 705 (COMM) **APPROPRIATIONS. 'AN ACT ESTABLISHING AN OFFICE OF PANDEMIC AND PUBLIC HEALTH PREPAREDNESS'**, to establish an Office of Pandemic and Public Health Preparedness.

REF. APPROPRIATIONS

S.B. No. 820 (COMM) **GOVERNMENT ADMINISTRATION AND ELECTIONS. 'AN ACT CONCERNING A STATE VOTING RIGHTS ACT'**, to afford mechanisms for the challenge of certain election administration laws, practices or procedures that may impair the electoral rights of certain protected classes of individuals.

S.B. No. 1078 (RAISED) **GOVERNMENT ADMINISTRATION AND ELECTIONS. 'AN ACT CONCERNING CAMPAIGN FINANCE LAWS'**, to (1) specify that certain online solicitations for political contributions are excluded from the definition of "expenditure", (2) allow certain individuals or entities to make contributions to legislative candidate committees and caucus committees, and (3) remove restrictions on the ability of legislative caucus committees to make organization expenditures during primaries.

S.B. No. 1079 (RAISED) APPROPRIATIONS. 'AN ACT CONCERNING COMPETITIVENESS AND LABOR COSTS AT THE CONNECTICUT AIRPORT AUTHORITY', to allow certain employees of the Connecticut Airport Authority and require certain future employees of the authority to participate in retirement and benefit plans implemented by the authority.

S.B. No. 1080 (RAISED) APPROPRIATIONS. 'AN ACT CONCERNING VARIOUS REVISIONS TO THE TEACHERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM', to revise and update the teachers' retirement system statutes to align with current practices.

REF. APPROPRIATIONS

S.B. No. 1081 (RAISED) APPROPRIATIONS. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE INTEREST RATE RELATING TO TEACHERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM COST-OF-LIVING ALLOWANCES AND RESERVING CERTAIN LOTTERY FUND REVENUE FOR THE CONNECTICUT TEACHERS' RETIREMENT FUND BONDS SPECIAL CAPITAL RESERVE FUND', to revise the interest rate relating to adjustments of cost-of-living allowances under the teachers' retirement system and reserve certain Lottery Fund revenue for payment to the Connecticut Teachers' Retirement Fund Bonds Special Capital Reserve Fund prior to transfer to the regionalization subaccount within the regional planning incentive account.

S.B. No. 1082 (RAISED) APPROPRIATIONS. 'AN ACT CONCERNING A RETIRED TEACHER ADVISORY COUNCIL, THE MEMBERSHIP OF AND TERM LIMITS FOR THE TEACHERS' RETIREMENT BOARD, A CAP ON CERTAIN PROFESSIONAL FEES PAID BY THE BOARD, AND MEDICARE SUPPLEMENTAL PLANS FOR RETIRED TEACHERS', to (1) establish a Retired Teacher Advisory Council for the Teachers' Retirement Board; (2) require that an additional retired teacher be added to the board's membership; (3) institute term limits for board members; (4) cap the amount of certain professional fees paid by the board; and (5) require that the board offer a Medicare supplemental plan to retired teachers.
