Dear Members of the Transportation Committee,

If Connecticut is to meet its commitment to the Multi-State Zero Emission Vehicle Action Plan Memorandum of Understanding (ZEV Plan) we must have 150,000 registered EVs by 2025. As of January 1, 2021, there are 13,800.

It is clear that we must broaden our scope and ramp up our infrastructure in order to foster EV adoption. Opening up the state to allow Electric Vehicle sales directly to consumers would aid in this.

Sustainable Fairfield Task Force supports SB 127 and hope that you will pass this bill out of committee.
