The Committee on Labor and Public Employees reported through SEN. KUSHNER of the 24th Dist., Chairperson of the Committee on the part of the Senate, that the bill ought to pass.

AN ACT CONCERNING WORKING CONDITIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) The Labor Commissioner
- 2 shall adopt regulations, in accordance with the provisions of chapter 54
- 3 of the general statutes, regarding safe and equitable working conditions
- 4 for all employees in the state.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Section 1	<i>from passage</i>	New section
