Explanation

Sections 1 and 2, which allow the Governor to extend certain executive orders through April 15, 2022, codifies current practice and has no direct fiscal impact. Section 3 could result in a potential savings to local and regional school districts if the use of COVID-19 relief days results in fewer school days throughout the year. These savings would be related to energy and transportation expenditures and potentially staff costs (substitute teachers).
