## **OFA Fiscal Note**

## **Explanation**

This bill: 1) makes various changes to statutes related to the Office of the Child Advocate, 2) requires the Office of the Child Advocate advisory committee to meet at least three times a year with the Office of the Child Advocate, 3) extends whistleblower protections in existing law, 4) places a 14-day limit for which requested records shall be provided to the Child Advocate, and 5) requires the advisory committee to provide an annual evaluation of the office. This does not result in a fiscal impact.

Senate "A" strikes the original bill and its associated fiscal impact, thus becoming the bill with the above referenced fiscal impact.
