## **OFA Fiscal Note**

### **Explanation**

The bill requires the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) to assign personnel and provide other resources as appropriate for administration of the commercial driver's license (CDL) knowledge test in Department of Correction (DOC) facilities, resulting in a cost to DMV of up to \$20,000 annually. The actual cost would be dependent on decisions to be made by DOC and DMV.

Additionally, the bill requires DOC to make space and technology available for the preparation and administration of the CDL knowledge test to certain incarcerated people, as described in the bill, and does not result in a fiscal impact to DOC.

Senate "A" alters the original bill by requiring DOC to make space available for test preparation and has no fiscal impact.
