The substitute language:

- Inserts a definition of "adult only tobacco retail store" to prohibit entrance of people under age 21 into such establishment (Section 1). "Adult only tobacco retail store" means a retail establishment that possess a dealer registration to sell electronic nicotine delivery systems (ENDS) or vapor products, or other tobacco related products;"
- Prohibits any person from selling, delivering, possessing with intent to sell any flavored or unflavored ENDS or vapor products unless they are an "adult only tobacco retail store" (Section 2);
- Strikes reference to the 35 milligrams per milliliter nicotine cap throughout the bill; and
- Sunsets these provisions on June 30, 2026.
