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ADDENDUM

To Fiscal Note on
sSB-176, File No. 348

AN ACT CONCERNING CLEAN ENERGY TARIFF PROGRAMS.

The scope of electricity supplies impacted by the bill would be encompassed by two state programs that subsidize certain ratepayers* at a cost to other (non-participating) ratepayers. Thus, any residential ratepayers (for example) who do not participate in either program would see their electricity rates increase by an estimated \$6.00 in total each year** once the programs have expanded fully (over the span of a few years) in accordance with the bill.
