AN ACT CONCERNING A STUDY REGARDING EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES FOR PERSONS WITH INTELLECTUAL AND DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) The Commissioner of Economic and
2 Community Development shall study programs developed in other
3 states to increase employment opportunities for persons with
4 intellectual and developmental disabilities. Not later than February 1,
5 2023, the commissioner shall report, in accordance with the provisions
6 of section 11-4a of the general statutes, regarding such study to the joint
7 standing committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of
8 matters relating to commerce.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
