**AN ACT CONCERNING FUNDING FOR HOME CARE AND  
ALZHEIMER'S DISEASE RESPITE CARE PROGRAMS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the sum of two million dollars be appropriated to the
- 2 Department of Social Services, from the General Fund, for the fiscal year
- 3 ending June 30, 2023, for the purpose of expanding access to the
- 4 Connecticut Home Care Program for the Elderly and that the sum of one
- 5 million dollars be appropriated to the Department of Aging and
- 6 Disability Services for the purpose of expanding access to the
- 7 Alzheimer's disease respite care program.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To increase funding for initiatives that allow seniors to age in place at home.
