AN ACT AUTHORIZING BONDS OF THE STATE FOR IMPROVEMENTS TO THE MATERIALS INNOVATION AND RECYCLING AUTHORITY'S WASTE MANAGEMENT PLANT IN HARTFORD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the State Bond Commission be empowered to authorize the
- 2 issuance of bonds of the state in accordance with section 3-20 of the
- 3 general statutes, in principal amounts not exceeding in the aggregate
- 4 three hundred thirty million dollars, the proceeds of which shall be used
- 5 by the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection for the
- 6 purpose of providing a grant-in-aid to the Materials Innovation and
- 7 Recycling Authority to make necessary upgrades and improvements to
- 8 the authority's waste management plant in Hartford.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide funding to the Materials Innovation and Recycling Authority to extend the operation of the authority's waste management plant in Hartford through June 2032.
