AN ACT AUTHORIZING BONDS OF THE STATE FOR A HANDICAP ACCESSIBLE PLATFORM AT THE WATERBURY STOP OF THE NAUGATUCK RAIL LINE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the State Bond Commission be empowered to authorize the
- 2 issuance of bonds of the state in accordance with section 3-20 of the
- 3 general statutes, in principal amounts not exceeding in the aggregate
- 4 ____ dollars, the proceeds of which shall be used by the Department of
- 5 Economic and Community Development for the purpose of providing
- 6 a grant-in-aid to the city of Waterbury to fund the design and
- 7 construction of a handicap accessible platform at the Waterbury stop of
- 8 the Naugatuck rail line.
