AN ACT EXEMPTING ACTIVE DUTY SERVICE MEMBERS AND CERTAIN VETERANS FROM FEES FOR MOTOR VEHICLE OPERATOR'S LICENSES OR REGISTRATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subsection (c) of section 14-50 of the 2022 supplement to
2 the general statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu
3 thereof (*Effective July 1, 2022*):

4 (c) The commissioner shall waive any operator's license or
5 registration fee, including any renewal fee, in the case of any person in
6 the active service of the armed forces of the United States; [who was a
7 legal resident of Connecticut at the time of his or her induction;] and for
8 one licensing period to any person who is a veteran, as defined in section
9 27-103, which [person] veteran applies for such operator's license or
10 registration within two years following the date of separation. [and was
11 a legal resident of Connecticut at the time of his or her induction.] The
12 commissioner may adopt regulations, in accordance with chapter 54, to
13 implement the provisions of this subsection.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:		
Section 1	July 1, 2022	14-50(c)

Statement of Purpose:

To exempt active duty service members who were not residents of Connecticut at the time of induction from fees for motor vehicle operator's licenses or registrations.
