**AN ACT EXTENDING THE PROVISIONS OF CERTAIN EXECUTIVE ORDERS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of special act 22-1 is amended to read as follows

2 (*Effective from passage*):

3 (a) Notwithstanding any provision of the general statutes, the  
4 provisions of Executive Order Number 14F issued by Governor Ned  
5 Lamont shall remain in effect through March 15, 2022.

6 (b) (1) Notwithstanding any provision of the general statutes, the  
7 following provisions of executive orders issued by Governor Ned  
8 Lamont shall remain in effect through April 15, 2022: (A) [Section 1 of  
9 Executive Order Number 7P; (B)] Section 3 of Executive Order Number  
10 9Q; [(C) Section 4 of Executive Order Number 12D; (D)] (B) except as  
11 provided in subsection (c) of this section, Executive Order Number 13A;  
12 [(E) Executive Order Number 13C; (F) Executive Order Number 13E;  
13 (G)] (C) the provisions of Executive Order Number 13G, as amended by

14 Executive Order Number 14C, concerning state hospital employees and  
15 excluding provisions concerning state employees and covered workers;  
16 [(H)] (D) Section 4 of Executive Order Number 14A; [(I)] (E) Executive  
17 Order Number 14B; and [(J)] (F) Sections 1 to 6, inclusive, of Executive  
18 Order Number 14D.

19 (2) For purposes of the executive orders listed in subdivision (1) of  
20 this subsection, "through April 15, 2022" shall be substituted for any  
21 references to "for the duration of the public health and civil  
22 preparedness emergency". [For purposes of Section 4 of Executive Order  
23 Number 12D, "on or before February 15, 2022" shall be inserted after the  
24 phrase "an application is made by the landlord or the tenant to  
25 UniteCT", and "unless further stayed by the court" shall be inserted after  
26 the phrase "whichever is earlier".]

27 (3) For purposes of the provisions of (A) Executive Order Number  
28 13G, as amended by Executive Order Number 14C, concerning state  
29 hospital employees and excluding provisions concerning state  
30 employees and covered workers, and (B) subsection b. of Section 3 of  
31 Executive Order Number 14B, "March 7, 2022" shall be substituted for  
32 references to "February 11, 2022". No civil penalty or other penalty  
33 authorized under said executive orders shall be imposed against any  
34 long-term care facility for a violation of subsection b. of Section 3 of  
35 Executive Order Number 14B or against any state hospital for a violation  
36 of Section 1 of Executive Order Number 14C for any such violation  
37 occurring on and after February 11, 2022, and prior to March 7, 2022.

38 (c) (1) Notwithstanding any provision of the general statutes, the  
39 provisions of Section 1 of Executive Order Number 9 and the provisions  
40 of Section 1 of Executive Order Number 13A authorizing masks or cloth  
41 face coverings to be required in schools, issued by Governor Ned  
42 Lamont, shall remain in effect through June 30, 2022.

43 (2) Any rule, order, directive or other guidance issued by the  
44 Commissioners of Education, Early Childhood or Public Health  
45 pursuant to the executive orders listed in this subsection rescinding such  
46 requirement for mask or cloth face coverings in schools shall not take

47 effect any earlier than February 28, 2022.

48 (d) (1) Notwithstanding any provision of the general statutes, the  
49 following provisions of executive orders issued by Governor Ned  
50 Lamont shall remain in effect through June 30, 2022: (A) Section 1 of  
51 Executive Order Number 7P; (B) Section 4 of Executive Order Number  
52 12D; (C) Executive Order Number 13C; and (D) Executive Order  
53 Number 13E.

54 (2) For purposes of the executive orders listed in subdivision (1) of  
55 this subsection, "through June 30, 2022" shall be substituted for any  
56 references to "for the duration of the public health and civil  
57 preparedness emergency". For purposes of Section 4 of Executive Order  
58 Number 12D, "on or before February 15, 2022" shall be inserted after the  
59 phrase "an application is made by the landlord or the tenant to  
60 UniteCT", and "unless further stayed by the court" shall be inserted after  
61 the phrase "whichever is earlier".

62 [(d)] (e) Any department head, state agency, municipality or other  
63 governmental entity that relied on the provisions of the executive orders  
64 listed in subsection (a), (b), [or] (c) or (d) of this section to exercise  
65 authority may continue to rely on said provisions to exercise authority  
66 through (1) March 15, 2022, in the case of the executive order listed in  
67 subsection (a) of this section, (2) April 15, 2022, in the case of the  
68 executive orders listed in subsection (b) of this section, or (3) June 30,  
69 2022, in the case of the executive orders listed in [subsection] subsections  
70 (c) and (d) of this section.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
