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- 1 Strike subparagraph (D) of subdivision (1) of subsection (b) of section
2 1 in its entirety and substitute the following in lieu thereof:
- 3 "(D) Executive Order Number 13A, except (i) as provided in
4 subsection (c) of this section, and (ii) the parent or guardian of a child
5 enrolled in a licensed child care facility shall be permitted to opt his or
6 her child out of any requirement concerning masks or cloth face
7 coverings in licensed child care facilities or any rule, order, directive or
8 other guidance issued by the Commissioner of Early Childhood or
9 Public Health relating to such requirement concerning masks or cloth
10 face coverings in licensed child care facilities."

11 Strike subdivision (1) of subsection (c) of section 1 in its entirety and
12 substitute the following in lieu thereof:

13 "(c) (1) Notwithstanding any provision of the general statutes, the
14 provisions of Section 1 of Executive Order Number 9 and the provisions
15 of Section 1 of Executive Order Number 13A authorizing masks or cloth
16 face coverings to be required in schools, issued by Governor Ned
17 Lamont, shall remain in effect through June 30, 2022, except the parent
18 or guardian of a student shall be permitted to opt his or her child out of
19 any such requirement concerning masks or cloth face coverings in
20 schools or any rule, order, directive or other guidance issued by the
21 Commissioner of Education, Early Childhood or Public Health relating
22 to such requirement concerning masks or cloth face coverings in
23 schools."
