"AN ACT REVISING CERTAIN ABSENTEE VOTING ELIGIBILITY STATUTES."

- After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and internal references accordingly:
- "Sec. 501. Subsection (a) of section 9-21a of the general statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from passage*):
- 6 (a) The Secretary of the State, at [such times as the Secretary
 7 determines, may] <u>least annually, shall</u> cause a search to be made of
 8 computerized voter registration records to identify electors who may be
 9 registered in more than one town, <u>registered more than once in the same</u>
 10 <u>town or deceased</u>. The Secretary [may] <u>shall</u> compile, from such search,
 11 a list of possible duplicate registrations in any town or towns <u>and</u>
 12 possible registrations of deceased individuals and transmit such list to

the registrars of voters of the appropriate town or towns."
