SB 332

AN ACT PROHIBITING CERTAIN VEHICLE STORAGE AGREEMENTS AS A PRECONDITION TO VEHICLE TOWING.

SUMMARY

This bill prohibits wreckers from requiring owners of damaged vehicles to sign a contract for more than 24 hours of storage as a part of the towing consideration. Existing law already prohibits wreckers from requiring vehicle owners to sign a repair contract as part of the towing consideration or an authorization to estimate repairs until the tow job is complete.
