Title: AN ACT CONCERNING THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES AND CRIMINAL BACKGROUND CHECKS.

Statement of Purpose: To (1) specify that, for certain positions with state agencies that require criminal background checks, the Department of Administrative Services shall also require such checks, and (2) require that current employees of certain such positions be subject to such checks every five years instead of every ten years.
