Title: AN ACT CONCERNING CLEAN ENERGY TARIFF PROGRAMS.

Statement of Purpose: To: (1) Modify existing energy caps involving shared clean energy facilities, (2) permit electric distribution companies to own solar power generation facilities within the Shared Clean Energy Facility program, and (3) to allow commercial and industrial customers in the non-residential renewable energy tariff program to use their entire roof space for generation.
