No Fiscal Impact

The amendment creates procedural court changes to provide protection for persons receiving and providing reproductive health services in the state and does not result in a fiscal impact to the state or municipalities.

The amendment allows advanced practice registered nurses, nurse-midwives, and physician assistants to perform medication and aspiration abortions, which is not anticipated to result in a fiscal impact to the state.
