No Fiscal Impact

The amendment gives the Department of Revenue Services (DRS) authority for administering the Connecticut Hydrogen and Electric Automobile Purchase Rebate (CHEAPR) program instead of the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection (DEEP), along with associated funding. This transfer of authority and related funding from one agency to another would result in a savings to DEEP and a cost to DRS, but is not anticipated to have a net fiscal impact to the state.
