### ***OFA Fiscal Note***

#### ***No Fiscal Impact***

The amendment adds a provision requiring the Insurance Commissioner to adopt regulations requiring public adjusters to meet continuing education requirements, which has no fiscal impact. It is anticipated that any continuing education program will be structured so that costs associated with the program are incurred by the licensees.
