Potential Revenue Gain

The amendment requires the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection (DEEP) to create a fund for the mitigation of the impact of all future power agreements on migratory birds and marine wildlife and the remediation of environmental consequences of these agreements. This newly established fund could potentially generate revenue to the extent it receives revenue from various sources.
